MESSIANIC PSALMS

Yeshua (Jesus) visited His disciples on the evening of His resurrection and told them, "These are the words which I spoke to you while I was still with you, that all things must be fulfilled which were written in the Law of Moses and the Prophets and the Psalms concerning me." The New Testament contains verses from thirteen of the Psalms which are often referred to as the Messianic Psalms. Sometimes most of a Psalm refers to the Messiah, and sometimes only a verse or two. These Psalms are listed below with a brief description of their content and their New Testament reference.

As Paul encouraged Timothy to "study to show thyself approved, rightly dividing the word of God..." we would encourage you to use this pamphlet as a "springboard" to your future study about the Messiah in the Holy Scriptures.

Psalm 2 Messiah's Sonship

Psalm 69 Messiah's Work of Restoration

(John 2:17, 7:5, 15:24)

Psalm 91 Messiah's Temptation

(Matthew 4:6; Luke 4:10-11)

Psalm 102 Messiah at Creation and at the "End of Time"

(Hebrews 1:10-12)

Psalm 110 Messiah at the Right Hand of the Father

(Matthew 22:44; Luke 20:43; Acts 2:35; Hebrews 1:13, 10:13)

Psalm 118 Messiah the Chief Cornerstone

(Matthew 21:42; Mark 12:10; Luke 20:17; Acts 4:11; 1 Peter 2:7)
