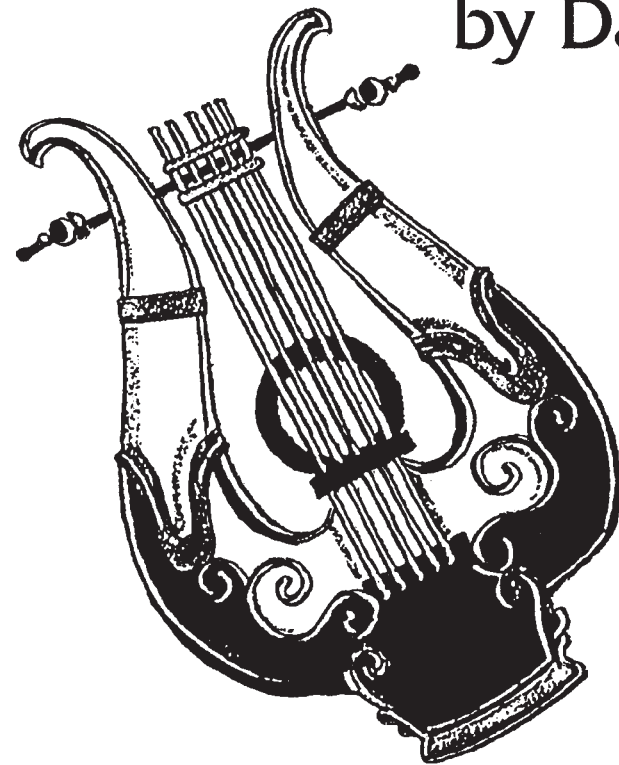

MESSIANIC PSALMS

Yeshua (Jesus) visited His disciples on the evening of His resurrection and told them, *“These are the words which I spoke to you while I was still with you, that all things must be fulfilled which were written in the Law of Moses and the Prophets and the Psalms concerning me.”* The New Testament contains verses from thirteen of the Psalms which are often referred to as the Messianic Psalms. Sometimes most of a Psalm refers to the Messiah, and sometimes only a verse or two. These Psalms are listed below with a brief description of their content and their New Testament reference.

As Paul encouraged Timothy to *“study to show thyself approved, rightly dividing the word of God...”* we would encourage you to use this pamphlet as a “springboard” to your future study about the Messiah in the Holy Scriptures.

Psalm 2 Messiah’s Sonship

(Acts 4:25-46 and 13:33; Hebrews 1:5 and 5:5;
Revelation 2:27; 12:5; and 19:15)

Psalm 8 Messiah’s Dominion Over Creation

(Matthew 21:16; 1 Corinthians 15:27;
Ephesians 1:20-22; and Hebrews 2:6-9)

Psalm 16 Messiah’s Resurrection

(Acts 2:25-28 and 13:35)

Psalm 22 Messiah’s Crucifixion

(Matthew 27:43,45-46; John 19:24, 28-30,37)

Psalm 40 Messiah’s Obedience

(Hebrews 10:5-7)

Psalm 41 Messiah’s Betrayal

(John 13:18-19)

Psalm 45 Messiah the Bridegroom-King, and His Bride

(Hebrews 1:8-9)

Psalm 68 Messiah’s Ascension

(Ephesians 4:8; James 1:17 inferred)

Psalm 69 Messiah’s Work of Restoration

(John 2:17, 7:5, 15:24)

Psalm 91 Messiah’s Temptation

(Matthew 4:6; Luke 4:10-11)

Psalm 102 Messiah at Creation and at the “End of Time”

(Hebrews 1:10-12)

Psalm 110 Messiah at the Right Hand of the Father

(Matthew 22:44; Luke 20:43; Acts 2:35;
Hebrews 1:13, 10:13)

Psalm 118 Messiah the Chief Cornerstone

(Matthew 21:42; Mark 12:10; Luke 20:17;
Acts 4:11; 1 Peter 2:7)

The Messiah Yeshua told some who came to hear Him speak: *“You search the Scriptures, for in them you think you have eternal life; and these are they which testify of Me.
